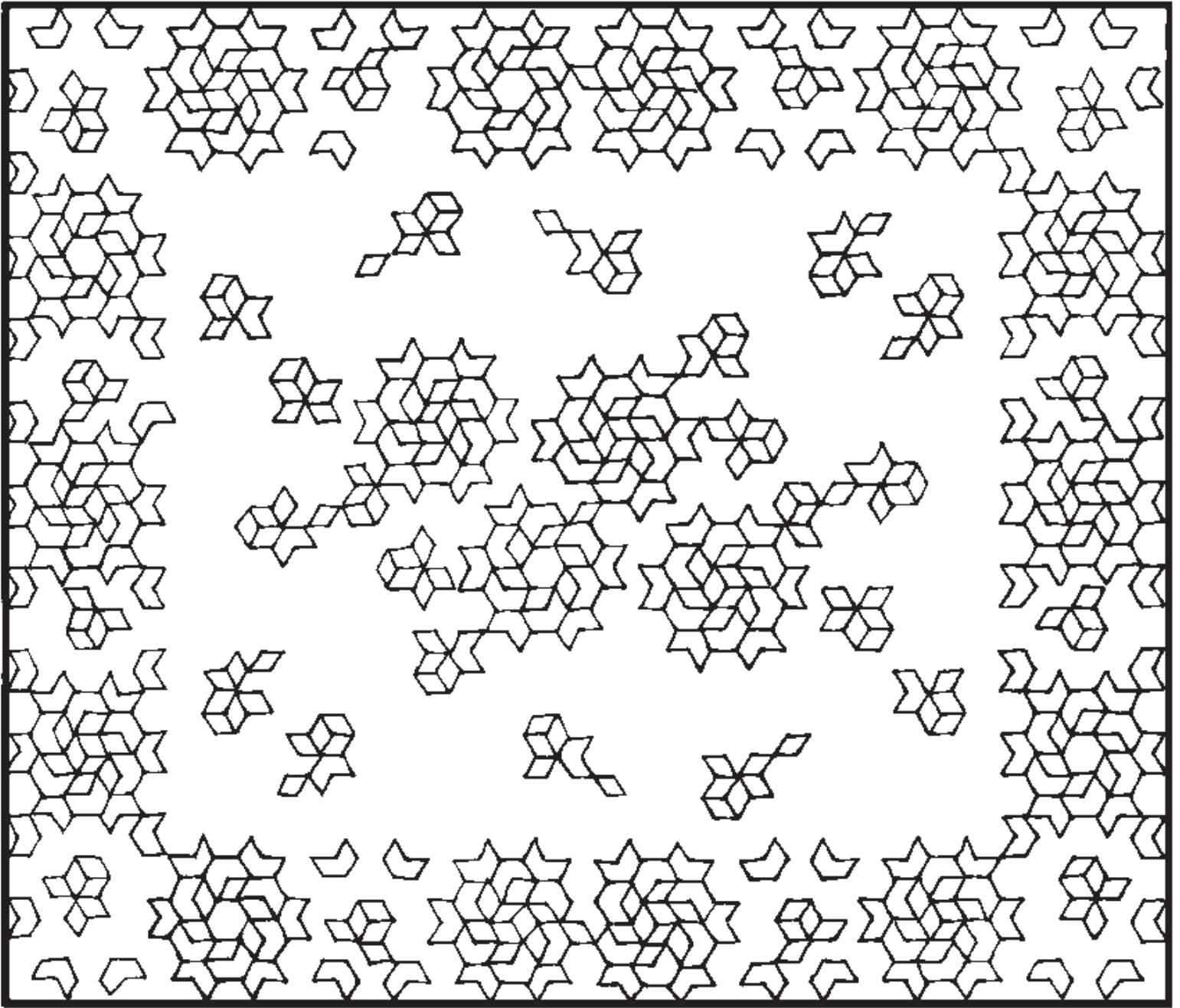


Whig Rose Quilt, Catherine Amanda Plymire, 1875

This quilt was likely created to celebrate the marriage of the artist's son. Its design is infused with a love theme represented by hearts covering the quilt surface.

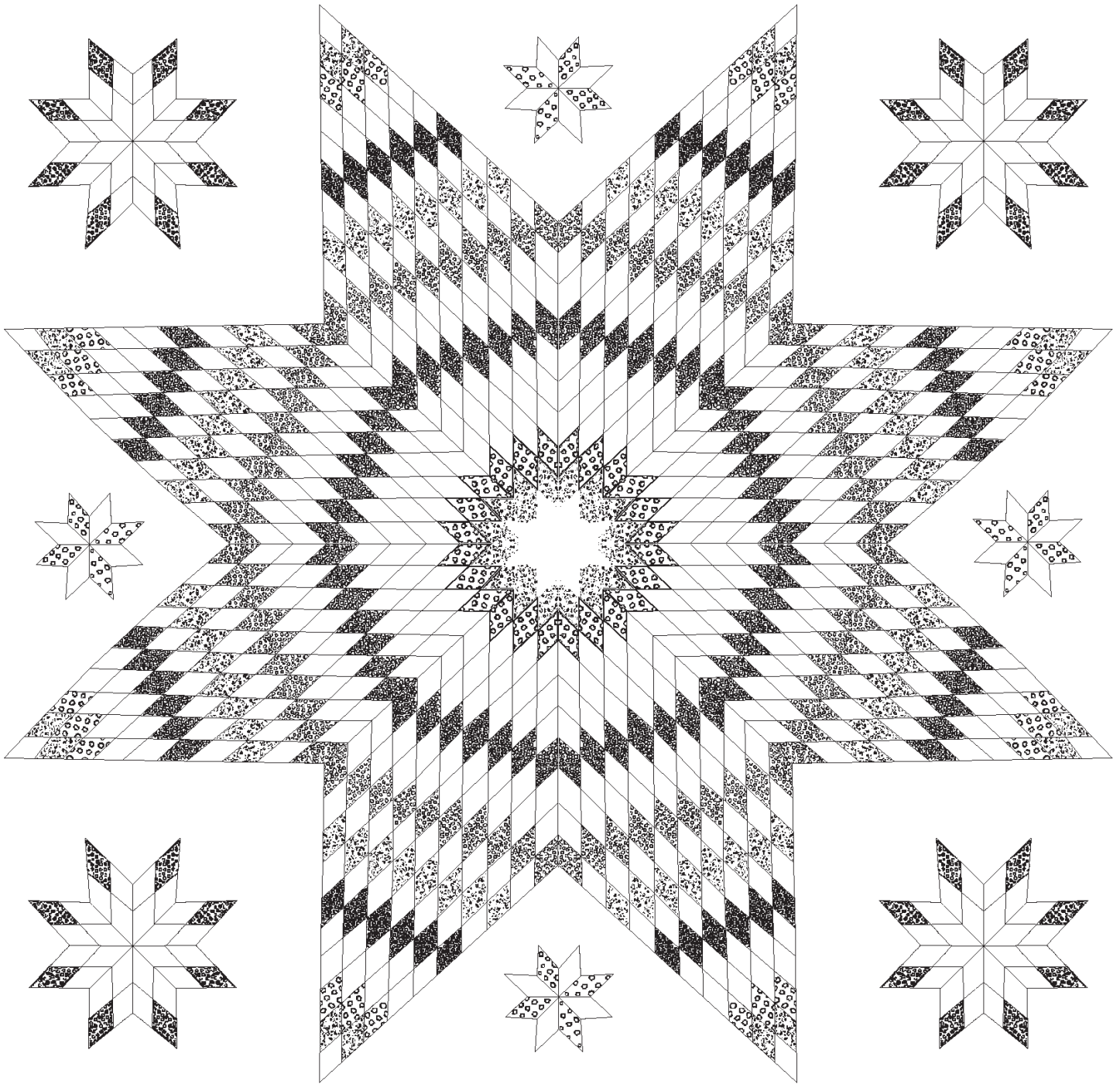




Gather Ye Rosebuds Quilt, Claire Moses, 1988

Based on a pattern by Jean Johnson, this quilt was constructed from 1566 individual diamonds and hexagons. The quilting process took more than 200 hours—over four months!
